

ORDINANCE 11-21-17

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND ESTABLISH SANITARY SEWER TAP FEES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ENTERPRISE AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the City Council finds in the interest of the citizens of Enterprise and the public welfare to amend the current sanitary sewer tapping fees to correspond to actual costs of the City associated with tapping into its sewer system related to residential and commercial buildings/projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Enterprise does ordain and enact as follows:


Section 1. The charge for tapping onto sanitary sewer shall be \$175.00 plus the actual material costs to the City related to said tapping for residential buildings/projects and \$225.00 plus the actual material costs to the City related to said tapping for commercial buildings/projects. The Public Works Department of the City shall present the owner, builder, person or entity who is obtaining the tap onto the sanitary sewer with an invoice establishing the actual material costs to the City related to said tap and said owner, builder, person or entity shall pay the same within thirty (30) days of receipt of such.


Section 2. If any part, section or subdivision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such holding shall not be construed to invalidate or impair the remainder of this Ordinance, which shall continue in full force and effect notwithstanding such holding.




Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and advertisement as required by law.






